ORDINANCE NO. 675

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4(A) OF ORDINANCE 562 ESTABLISHING AND MODIFYING LIMITATIONS FOR THE PARKING OF VEHICLES AND TRAILERS IN THE RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of New Cumberland, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same, an Ordinance amending provisions of Ordinance 562 regulating the parking of vehicles and trailers, reducing the number of traffic hazards on public streets and minimizing the risk of personal injury and property damage within the Borough of New Cumberland.

SECTION 1: AUTHORITY. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Borough Code, 53 P.S. Section 46202 (4) (NUISANCES), 53 P.S. SECTION 46202 (5) (NUISANCES AND DANGEROUS STRUCTURES; 53 P.S. Section 46202(6) (HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS); 53 P.S.460202 (17) STREET REGULATIONS; 53 P.S. Section 46202 (74) (GENERAL POWERS), and the Motor Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C.S.A. Section 3353(a)(1)(x) and (2)(i)(PARKING PROHIBITIONS IN SPECIFIED PLACES) and 75 Pa. C.S.A. Section 6109(a)(13) (REGULATING USE OF STREETS).

SECTION 2: AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE 562.

(A) Section 4 of Ordinance 562 is hereby amended and modified, as follows:

(A) **PARKING OF VEHICLES AND TRAILERS.**

(i) Residential District. No person(s) shall park any full trailer, semitrailer, bus, truck tractor, or any vehicle with a gross registered vehicle weight in excess of 7,000 pounds on

any street, laned roadway or streetway within any Residential District in the Borough of New Cumberland unless such vehicle or trailer is parked immediately adjacent to an established residence or other use of land and the owner or the owner's agents are in the active course of loading or unloading items to or from any vehicle or trailer to the place of residence or other use of land occupied, owned or used by the owner or resident thereof. Parking of any full trailer, semitrailer, bus, truck tractor, or any vehicle with a gross registered vehicle weight in excess of 7,000 pounds on a residential premises shall be limited to a period of time not exceeding twenty-four (24) hours for the purpose of loading, unloading or performing routine maintenance.

(ii) Commercial and Industrial Districts. No person(s) shall park any full trailer, semitrailer, bus, truck tractor, or any vehicle with a gross registered vehicle weight in excess of 7,000 pounds on any street, laned roadway or streetway within any Commercial or Industrial District in the Borough of New Cumberland unless such vehicle or trailer is parked immediately adjacent to an established commercial or industrial business or other use of land and the owner or the owner's agents are in the active course of loading or unloading items to or from any vehicle or trailer to the place of commercial, industrial business or other use of land occupied, owned or used by the owner or occupier thereof.

SECTION 3: CONTINUATION. The provisions of this ordinance, so far as they are the same as those of ordinances in force immediately prior to the enactment of this ordinance, are intended as a continuation of such ordinances and not as new enactments. Provisions of this ordinance shall not affect any act done or liability incurred, nor shall they affect any suit


or prosecution pending or to be instituted to enforce any right or penalty or to punish any offense under the authority of any ordinance repealed by this ordinance.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective in accordance with law.



In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this ordinance or other ordinances affected by this ordinance, it being the intent of the Borough of New Cumberland that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.


